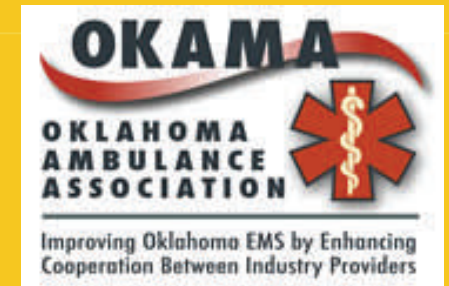

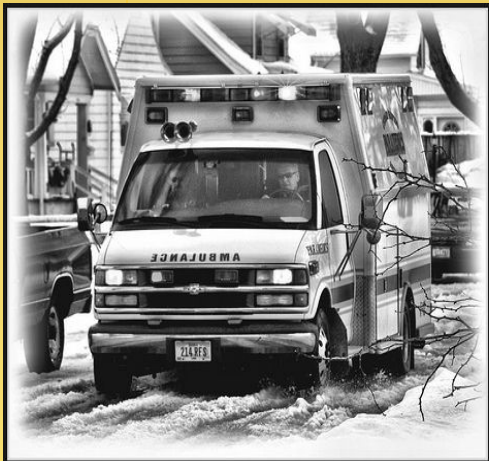

The State of the State Address - EMS in Oklahoma
In this session Shawn will discuss the challenges facing EMS in the state of Oklahoma; highlighting the past year's legislative successes and discussing the challenges of 2009 and beyond.
Shawn Rogers is the Director of the EMS Division for the State of Oklahoma. Shawn worked in the Emergency Room as a Nurse which eventually led him to EMS. He worked as an EMT, Intermediate and Paramedic at AmCare in Oklahoma City until 1985, when he moved to Yukon EMS. He became the director there in 1986, and started teaching paramedic courses at Moore-Norman Vo-Tech. He was one of the first PHTLS instructors in Oklahoma.

H1N1: The coming plague? Or much ado about nothing.

This session will help agencies prepare a proportional plan in response to the coming surge in influenza cases this fall.
